



PARENT/GUARDIAN'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of Conduct defines the expectations for players. Bellevue Shockers Softball Association firmly believes that for the sports experience is to be a positive, safe, and an enjoyable learning experience for youth of the league. Because of the excitement and high emotion of some of our games, we thought it important to express some guidelines regarding what we expect from you, our parents, and your children. Please know that we encourage cheering, and exuberance, but please be careful to express this in a positive manner.

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following the Parent/Guardians' Code of Ethics:

Parent/Guardian's Code of Conduct:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
- I will praise my child's efforts and always offer my support.
- I will never voice any complaints or concerns toward coaches, referees or league officials in front of the children.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Ethics.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will only use social media to portray BSA in a positive, professional manner.
- I will make every effort to attend and be on time for all team events. If I am not in attendance of the event I will make every effort to promptly pick up my child or make arrangements for their safe return to home.
- I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
- I will have all fees paid by January 1 or have an approved alternate payment plan or incur a \$25 late fee

Failure to comply with these rules may result in a player, parent, or both facing disciplinary actions. Serious or repeated offenses could result in suspension or release from the team with absolutely no refund of your registration fee.
